


THIS / THAT/ THESE / THOSE

*We use these and those to talk about more than one person or thing.

Singular	 <u>This</u> is an apple.	 <u>That</u> is an apple.
Plural	 <u>These</u> are apples.	 <u>Those</u> are apples.
