**Adverbs of Manner: These adverbs, which show the manner in which some action is done.**

**Adverbs of Manner answer the question “How?”**

**Adverbs of Time: They tell us when the action is done.**

**Adverbs of Time answer the question “When?”**

**Adverbs of Place: They tell us where the action is done.**
