Ans: Five times each day, the world's Muslims, wherever they may be, turn to the

Holy City of Makkah to pray. And at least once in their lives, Muslims from all over the world perform the Hajj, the pilgrimage to Makkah. As a result, Makkah has become one of the most cosmopolitan and diverse cities in the Muslim world.

4. Mention the significant features of the city of Makkah?

Ans: Makkah houses the Masjid al- Haram, the largest mosque in the world. The Holy mosque in Makkah houses the Kaabah, in the corner of which is set the black Stone. The Zamzam Well is home to a celebrated water spring. Hira is a cave near Mecca, on the mountain named Jabal Al- Nur in the Hejaz region of present day Saudi Arabia. The Holy City is served by the seaport and International airport of Jeddah.

5. Write a brief note on Jannatul Baqee.

Ans: The graveyard of Madinah (Jannatul Baqee), has a large number of Al – Sahabah Al Kiram (companions of the Prophet) including Usman, Abbas. Hassan (The Grandson of the Prophet), and wives and daughters of the Holy Prophet also buried there. This graveyard is close to the Tomb of the Holy Prophet Muhammad (P. B. U. H.), right after the courtyard of Masjid- e- Nabwi.
