a) Common Nouns: These are the common names (**general names**) of any person, place, thing or animal)

**Examples: doctor



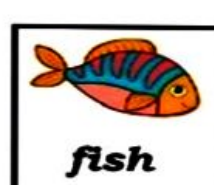
